- 6 topics providing diverse perspectives on ENDS (Electronic Nicotine Delivery Systems):
 1. History (6 components)
 2. ENDS Devices (7 components)
 3. eCigarettes in Schools (15 components)
 4. Marketing ENDS to Kids (8 components)
 5. The Chemicals in ENDS (6 components)
 6. The Hazardous Effects of eCigarettes (9 components)
- There is one forum (discussion) in which you participate with peers
- There is one assignment (in chapter 3) to create an asset for teaching **ENDS** prevention
- An emphasis on your creativity and using your strengths
- A final test evaluates your learning (10-12 questions - MC)
- Creating your own lesson
 - Create one lessons to teach
 - Statistical analysis to demonstrate the impact of your teaching
